- Arrange the game with the assigner at least one (1) week in advance
- Contact the DDA with the details of the game
- DDA assigns the assessor
- On the same day mail a check or money order for the game fee to the SDA and notify SDA of assessment (mail address below)
- Check or money order payable to STSR

Grade 6 Assessment

Upgrades or Maintenance

- Arrange the game with the assigner two (2) weeks in advance
- Send e-mail to the SDA and notify SDA of assessment and include the details of the game
- SDA contacts DDA who assigns assessor
- On the same day mail a check or money order for the game fee to the SDA (mail address below)
- Check or money order payable to STSR

Grade 5 Assessment

Upgrades or Maintenance

- Arrange the game with the assigner two (2) weeks in advance
- Send e-mail to the SDA to notify of assessment and include the details of the game
- SDA assigns assessor
- On the same day mail a check or money order for the game fee to the SDA (mail address below)
