STYSA President Ed Loucks:

Referee training available at STYSA Cup competitions. Levels of competition can provide different referee development and assessment opportunities.  
STYSA will support sanctions for referee abuse.

STSR recommends use only KidSafe registered refs for youth games.  
Assignor registration fee increase proposed for 2008 to \$20 to enhance service.
